

PURPOSE

Adopt-A-Spot is a volunteer program to demonstrate the care of our community with beautification, litter prevention and control. This allows individuals, families, groups, organizations and businesses to adopt an area to perk up and maintain. An area may need painting, cutting, weeding, plants, benches, and/or litter receptacles — in other words, a little TLC. You will be expected to maintain this area on a regular basis, at least twice annually.

BENEFITS

- ✓ Reduces costs in dollars and manpower involved in time-consuming operation of sprucing up areas.
- \checkmark Provides a way in which local citizens can show community pride.
- \checkmark Demonstrates personal responsibility and changes attitudes regarding littering.
- \checkmark Clean, attractive cities promote economic development.

ADOPTER RESPONSIBILITIES

✓ Fill out the application form for your chosen area and return it to Keep Sherwood Beautiful for approval by our Public Works Department. Keep in mind available facilities such as water for plants. An area may need painting, weeding, planting and/or picking up. You might add trash receptacles, bird baths, benches, etc.

 \checkmark You will be expected to maintain this area on a regular basis (at least twice a year).

✓ Immediately after each work session, complete the Report Form and return it to KSB. This information goes to Keep Arkansas Beautiful and Keep America Beautiful in annual reports

 \checkmark If you have trash to be picked up, call the Public Works Department at 501-835-3288 to report the contents and location.

 \checkmark Observe the enclosed Safety Rules and Regulations.

- \checkmark Get supplies, if you need them, from KSB and return what you borrow.
- \checkmark Be sure each volunteer is properly dressed. Have plenty of water, sanitizer and supplies available.

SUPPLIES

Participants may request available supplies from Keep Sherwood Beautiful. These will be given to the person on record as in charge. ONE-TIME USE:

- 1. Safety Vests
- 2. Gloves
- 3. Trash Bags
- CHECK IN/OUT: 1. Pickers 2. Signs 3. Garden Tools

ADOPT-A-SPOT SAFETY RULES & REGULATIONS

The safety of volunteers is the number one priority of this program. Please have each volunteer read or go over this collectively.

 \checkmark All under the age of 18 must be properly supervised by adults.

 \checkmark Work in your area must be done during daylight hours.

 \checkmark Wear appropriate attire according to what you will be doing and the weather. Wearing gloves and a hat is highly suggested.

✓ Safety vests should be worn and are available from Keep Sherwood Beautiful.

- \checkmark It is suggested you have a small first aid kit available.
- \checkmark Sunscreen should be applied during any time of the year.
- ✓ Have plenty of water available for all.
- \checkmark Utility installations, culverts and drainage ditches should be off limits.
- \checkmark Do not climb into anything.

 \checkmark Do not pick up hazardous materials, very large or heavy objects – make a note of the item and location to report to our Public Works Department at 501-835-3288.

 \checkmark Be sure someone in your group has a mobile phone for emergency contact. Have emergency contact numbers for all volunteers.

✓ Stay clear of traffic.

 \checkmark Most of all have fun, enjoy each other's company and BE SAFE!

We understand because of limited spacing on the Adopt-A-Spot signs, group names may have to be abbreviated and have written its name in the application above as it is to appear on the sign.
